Technical Requirements

Devices Supported

This app requires Android 4.4 (KitKat) or higher and will run on any device that supports this OS. For best performance, it is recommended that the app be used on Android 5.0 (Lollipop) and higher.

SharePoint Platforms Supported

Connectivity is supported for the following editions of SharePoint:

- SharePoint 2010
- SharePoint 2013
- SharePoint Online (Office 365)

SharePoint Security and Privileges

By using SharePoint's web services to access SharePoint data, Colligo Briefcase for Android respects all privileges defined on the site. Colligo Briefcase for Android supports most standard sign-on processes supported by SharePoint, including support for default credentials and other specified credentials.

Colligo Briefcase for Android supports Claims-based and Forms-based authentication, as well as ADFS. SharePoint by default does not provide web service permissions to anonymous users, so this permission level cannot be used for uploading documents to SharePoint.

| Briefcase for Android build 1.0.2.129 – Known Issues | |

| Reference | Description |
| XAM-750 | Intermittent crash when removing a subsite/library from the Offline stream. (The crash happens when the same SharePoint subsite/library is removed from the Offline stream the second time.) |
| XAM-773 | Unable to share a file from Microsoft OneDrive. |
| XAM-792 | When copying an email to a new SharePoint location, the destination file will have metadata properties for Email Subject and Title overwritten with content from the Subject field. Workaround: Re-enter the correct values when the Properties page is displayed. |
| XAM-800 | Files added while offline are not uploaded to SharePoint if the user upgrades to a newer release of the app prior to syncing. Workaround: Sync the app prior to upgrading. |

| XAM-719 | Sync here doesn't immediately sync the file when it is shared from an external app into Android Briefcase. Workaround: Navigate out and come back into the folder where the file was uploaded. Press Sync Here to sync the file. |
| XAM-738 | Progress bar does not stop moving after pressing Stop Sync . |
| XAM-743 | Adding a site as Pinned Location in Colligo Console with a Favorite policy does not push down the site as a Favorite. |
